Heart Sisters. She attended West Catholic High School, and was inducted in 2005 into the school's Hall of Fame in recognition of her ministry as a Little Sister of the Poor.

Mother went with her friends to volunteer at the Little Sisters' home, and it was then that she experienced the call of Christ through this attraction to their specific charism of seeing Jesus in those they served.
