Due to the rapid increase of new cases of COVID 19 in Delaware and throughout the country, we must institute some changes in order to protect the Residents, visitors, volunteers, sisters and staff.

- Vaccinated visitors and Residents must again wear masks during visits.
- We ask once again for families to take their loved ones only to their home, not to a restaurant or out shopping.
- Residents coming back from the hospital or overnight visit may need to quarantine.

At this time, it is important to remind everyone of some basic rules.

- Everyone must ensure they are wearing their masks properly. Which means over their mouth and nose when in public spaces.
- It is important to remain 6 feet apart whenever possible.
- Masks must be worn at all activities and in public spaces.
- We need to continue to sanitize all high touch surfaces. All of us can pitch in to ensure that is done.
