Scheduled visitations for the other units can occur, call Raj to schedule appointments. Outdoor visits are preferred. Thank God the weather has been very nice and it should continue for a little while.

Everyone has been very cooperative, this assures us that we are in a safe environment. Hopefully, we will soon be able to return to the normal routine of daily life. The great spirit of the Residents and the staff shows that caring is what we really are all about.
