This surge has included 6 staff and 5 Residents. Recently, 5 Residents on our Holy Family unit tested positive for Covid without showing symptoms. Any Resident who tested positive were moved to the Covid area. All are doing well and will be out of the Covid Unit shortly. We are encouraging the Residents to be extra cautious when coming out of their rooms. They must wear masks when walking in the hallways. Due to staff positives, we have also tested Residents in Mary Immaculate Unit, all of whom were negative.

We thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate through this surge. We remain optimistic, but vigilant in our policies and procedures in protecting our Residents, Staff, Volunteers and Visitors.

When visiting the Home, we encourage an understanding that by entering the Jeanne Jugan Residence, there is a risk possibly being exposed to COVID19. With this said, we ask everyone to follow the guidelines, most importantly the wearing of a mask, proper handwashing and maintaining the 6 feet distance separation.

We continue to look to the Holy Family and St. Jeanne Jugan for their continued protection upon all our loved ones, especially Residents, their Families our devoted Staff, and Volunteers.
