Dear Family and Friends,

This is to keep you well informed and up-to-date on the follow-up of the letter from last week. As of today, January 20, 2022, a Resident on Holy Family has tested positive for COVID-19. Currently, the Resident that tested positive is asymptomatic, and we continue to take extreme precautions to ensure everyone's safety. The other Residents that previously tested positive are doing well and are no longer required to be isolated.

If you have not been contacted personally, the positive Covid test does not apply to your loved one. To reduce transmission, residents that test positive are moved to a COVID-19 area specifically prepared to handle these cases. We continue to routinely test staff and residents and are monitoring all residents, staff and visitors for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.

We strongly encourage all Residents and Staff to get fully vaccinated. Due to new CMS guidelines, Residents who are fully vaccinated and boosted with a negative test, that do not require quarantining to their rooms are permitted to resume regular day to day activities, go to the dining room for meals, attend Mass or receive visitors. All Residents either positive or negative may receive visitors.

When planning to visit, *be mindful of the high transmission rates of these variants* and the impact visitations can have on your loved one. We're all in this together, so let's continue to do all we can to keep each other safe.
